

## Frequently Answered Questions

### **A) Whether the accommodation is available within the campus?**

The accommodation is available for all the recommended candidates inside the campus and it is advisable to take accommodation within the campus as it is safer and convenient amidst the present ongoing Covid 19 pandemic. However, all the covid norms issued by the institute from time to time have to be followed.

### **B) When is the course registration scheduled?**

The course registration is scheduled on 29th July 2021 and lasts up to 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021. The course registration will take place through google form. The list of the courses, the syllabi etc will be made available by 28th July 2021 on institute website. Please keep checking the institute website and emails regularly for updates in this regard.

### **C) What is the deadline to pay fees and send documents?**

Please note that the deadline to send documents and pay the fees remains the same as in the fee circular available on the website.

### **D) Will my admission get cancelled if I don't pay the fees and send requested documents?**

The admission is liable to be cancelled for those candidates who are failing to send acceptance of offer letter & other documents and failing to pay the fees. No prior intimation will be given to such candidates.

### **E) What is the procedure to avail hostel facility and instructions regarding arrival to the campus?**

The campus is open to the students on voluntary basis. A permission from your parent/guardian is also necessary. A 1<sup>st</sup> dose vaccination certificate, RTPCR test reports are mandatory. Please check your emails for detailed procedure regarding arrival to the campus.

### **F) When will the classes begin?**

The classes will commence from 2nd August 2021 in an online or offline mode or both. However, the students are advised to come to the campus and undergo offline mode of teaching as the offline mode is a more efficient way. And the classes may run in an online mode, however the evaluation (quizzes, tests, mid sem/end sem exams etc) will happen in an offline mode when you return to the campus only).

### **G) How often a candidate should check email and institute website?**

Updates if any will be shared via email or on institute website or both. It is advisable of candidates to keep checking emails and institute website at least 4-5 times in a day till the classes begin.

### **H) When is the right time to come to the campus?**

It is advisable to come to the campus by 24th or 25th July 2021, so that quarantine period of one week would be completed by the time of beginning of instructions ( 2nd August 2021)

### **I) What is the list of documents to be sent?**

- Signed offer letter
- 10th marks card
- 12th marks card / Diploma marks cards
- Bachelor's degree marks cards
- Bachelor's degree certificate / provisional degree certificate
- Master's degree marks cards (for PhD candidates)
- Master's degree certificate/ provisional degree certificate (for PhD candidates)
- Relieving letter from your organization if you are presently working
- A handwritten letter that you are not drawing salary/stipend/financial assistance from any other source that you will be receiving only stipend from IIT Dharwad as per the Govt. of India norms (for TA category students). The letter will be addressed to AR (Academics). The letter will be duly signed by you mentioning your full name, department details etc.
- A handwritten letter that you are not drawing salary/stipend/financial assistance from any other source that you will be receiving only stipend from IIT Dharwad as per the norms applicable. And please mention in the letter that you are aware about the duration and norms of funding (for Fellowship Awardee, Project Assistant, Project Associate, CSR category students etc.). The letter will be addressed to AR (Academics). The letter will be duly signed by you mentioning your full name, department details etc.
- Vaccination certificate / Covid positive certificate (if you tested positive)
- Willingness letter from you that you want to come to the campus and ready to go back if the situation worsened due to Covid
- A handwritten permission letter from your parent/ guardian, duly signed by him with his full name and address
- Aadhar card copy
- Scanned copy of your passport size photograph
